Will your child be five years old on or before December 1st, 2018? If so, as of September he or she will be eligible for public school programming. At this time of year, we begin the transition process at Helping Hands for students who will be leaving us in September. Our upcoming parent night is devoted to a presentation and discussion about the transition to public school programming. A letter will be sent home to parents of eligible children this month. The presentation will include a discussion of regulations which are followed in the process and a general overview of program options available in school districts. We hope to alleviate some of the anxiety parents often feel as transition time approaches. We encourage you to attend and to bring your ideas and questions. Childcare will be available. Childcare registration forms will come home with your child later this month. (snow date 1/31)
