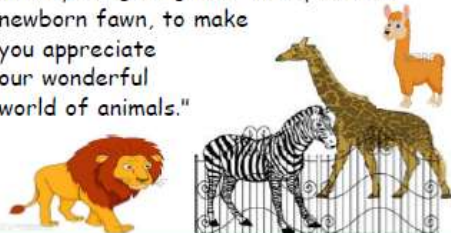


Summer Reading Clubs

Water Safety Tips



Summer is here and for many that means outdoor fun at the beach or at a pool. Water safety should be the priority.

1. Find an appropriate typical or adaptive life jacket that best meets your child's needs and be sure your child wears it anytime he or she is near any open water including pools, lakes, rivers, fountains, ponds or hot tubs.
2. Always be within arms reach of your child when he or she is in or near any open water.
3. Drain bathtubs and other small containers such as buckets of water when you are finished using them.
4. Be sure to explain basic water safety practices to your child on a regular basis and remind your child to never go near or in the water without an adult.

Enjoy water fun together, but always prioritize safety.

Let the children spend time during the day decorating boxes and getting ready for a drive-in movie night at home. Pop some popcorn and/or other snacks and at movie time, everyone climbs into their own "car" and watches the movie. Sounds like fun!
