Suzanne's Playground, 13 Wood Thrush Ct., Ballston Spa, is an inclusive playground designed so that children of all abilities can play together. Soft surfaces, wheelchair accessibility, sensory panels and tandem swings are just some of its features. Stop in to play! (Located off Geysler Rd.)

The Crossings, Colonie

This huge, 30 acre park opened in 2003 and is definitely worth a visit. The park features a "barrier-free" playground as well as walking trails, a tree maze and many picnic tables in sun and shade. Visit www.colonie.org/parks/crossings/ for more information.

Kids' Creekside Village at Kelley Park, Ballston Spa

This community-built playground was designed with the input of local children and built by 1200 volunteers. It features equipment that can be used by children of all ages and abilities.
